Consider:

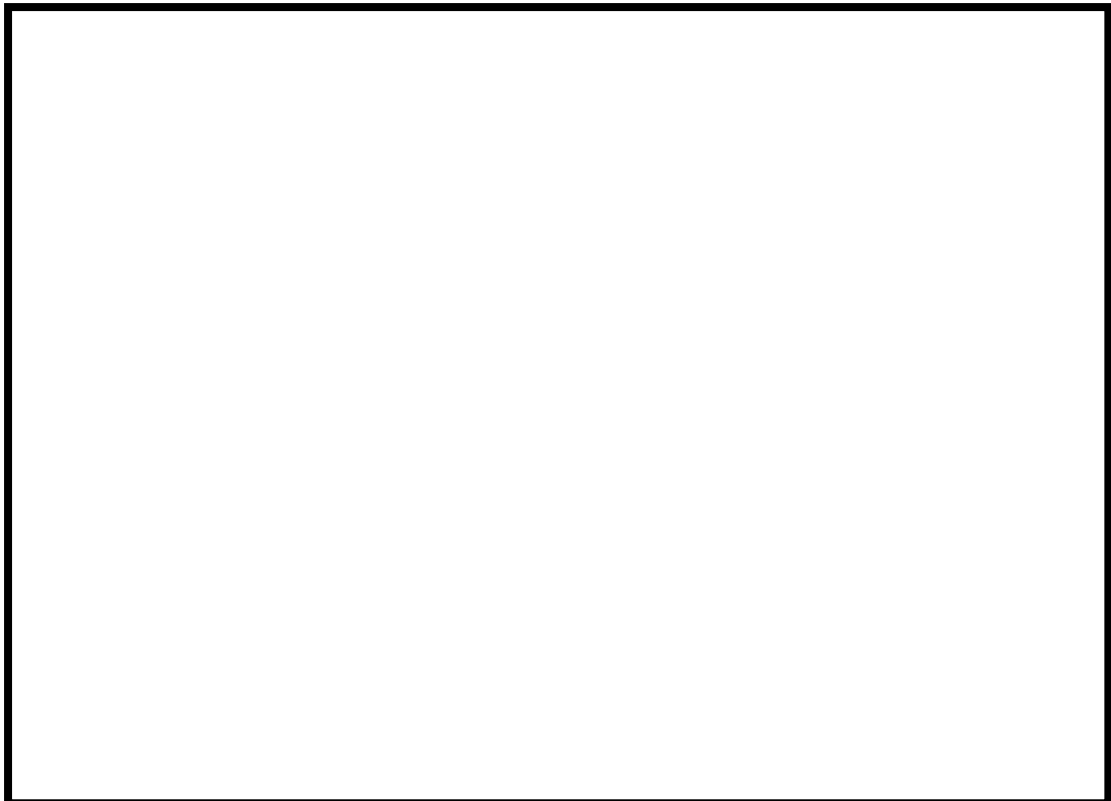
